Aim: The objective of the course is to encourage students to watch plays from a variety of genres in order to

- develop their skills in recognising and effectively evaluating plays as theatre productions
- neatly and efficiently compose their critical views of the productions
- become familiar with set, costume and lighting designs and to enhance their skills in “reading” these theatrical components
- enhance appreciation of the structure, plot, characterisation, theme and message of the plays
- identify major theatre genres like the musical, epic theatre, in-her-face theatre and mono theatre
- be made aware of the different playhouses/stages in Ankara, including both public and private theatres, their structures and stages
- eventually, to develop a better, deeper understanding of theatre productions and to enhance critical awareness

Since the programmes for the months of March, April and May are not out yet, other plays for this season will also be included and announced later.

Textbooks: Students are expected to provide the books, journals and magazines at the beginning of the semestre.

Requirements:

- Each student is expected to see 5 plays during the semestre and write 3-page reviews with 1.50 line spacing, and a Works Cited on any 2 of these.
- Attendance is obligatory; more than 11 hours of absence will result in F1.
- Students are expected to come to class on time, having watched the assigned play(s), and prepared to present their reviews

Method of Instruction: The course will be conducted through lecturing, occasional group work and class discussions. In addition there will be 10-minute student presentations of the play reviews.

Assessment:

Mid-Term Exam: 20%
2 Written Reviews: 20% (10% each)
A 10-min. Oral Presentation of a Review (not written): 10%
Final Exam: 50%

Students must receive at least 50 points over 100 from the Final Exam. Plagiarism will result in F3. In the grading of all written and oral work 25% will be taken off for English mistakes.
